Class 3 Curriculum Summer Term 2007

This term our literacy work begins with the study of myths. The children will be getting to know the characters in the ancient Greek myths, reading and writing a number of stories. Later this term we shall be writing a range of poems.

Our maths work continues to follow the renewed framework. By the end of this term year 3 children are expected to know their 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 10 times tables along with the corresponding divisions. Children in year 2 should know their 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

In science we will be experimenting with light and shadows and forces.

In history and geography we will be investigating our local area and how it has changed over time.

In ICT we shall continue developing basic skills and also start to use databases and modelling software.

In RE we shall consider the stories of Jesus and why the Torah is important to Jews.

In PE the children will enjoy summer team games in addition to developing their athletic skills.

In music the children will be learning a range of traditional songs.
