Class 3 Curriculum Spring Term 2008

This term our literacy work begins with the study of traditional stories. The children will be getting to know typical characters in these stories and we will be looking at the punctuation of speech.

Later this term we shall be writing a range of instructions and shape poems.

Our maths work continues to follow the renewed framework. By the end of this term year 3 children are expected to know their 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 10 times tables along with the corresponding divisions. Children in year 2 should know their 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Many children have made great progress using Mathletics at home. Children will be moved on to more challenging course work once the current areas have been completed.

In science we will be looking at living things and how plants grow.

In history we will be investigating World War 2 and hope to arrange a visit in order to support this work.

In ICT we shall continue developing basic skills and to use modelling software.

In RE we shall consider the life of Jesus and Easter.

In PE the children will enjoy small team games in addition to dance.
