Allocation Statement for Enmore C of E Primary School

Enmore Church of England Primary School received 44 preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd choices). **This school has a published Admission Number of 21.** 29 children were allocated higher preference schools by the Local Authority, reducing the number of preferences to 15. Therefore **15 places have been offered in the first round.**

Six applications were received in the second round, 2 children were allocated higher preference schools by the Local Authority, reducing the number of preferences in the second round to 4. Therefore, **4 places were offered in the second round.**

June 2019 – 1 application was received from an applicant changing their choice of school which was offered.

August 2019 – A child who had previously been offered a place changed their choice of school – the place at this school was therefore declined by the applicant

How the Allocation of Places was made:

The 19 places have been offered to pupils under the following criteria.

	Criterion	Number of places offered
1.	Looked After Children and previously Looked After Children. (Previously looked after children are children who were looked after, but ceased to be so because they were adopted, or became subject to a residence order or special guardianship order)	0
2.	Children who at the time of application reside in the ecclesiastical parishes of Enmore or Goathurst;	1
3.	Children with a sibling (living at the same address) attending the school at the time the child will start school;	9
4.	Children of school staff	0
5	Any further places will be decided by proximity of the child's home to the school, as measured by the shortest distance, using a GIS system if necessary. (The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 5.944 miles).	9
