## Parking

Please continue to use the car park with care. No children should be dropped off in the school car park in the morning and allowed to walk to the gates unattended. Please park and walk children to the gate.

Please avoid parking on the zig- zag lines adjacent to the car park exit as this makes leaving the car park very dangerous.

## School Gate

If you are dropping off children late, collecting early or visiting at any other times, please ensure that the gate is shut behind you.

## School Closure

This is the time of year when the school can be forced to close due to heavy falls of snow. We do endeavour to remain open whenever possible and parents should assume that the school is open unless they hear otherwise.

If we are unable to open, parents will be sent a text message as soon as a decision is made.

If we are forced to close during a school day, parents should endeavour to collect their children as soon as possible. The after school club will not operate on these days.

Should the school be unable to open for a number of days, work would be set through Google Classroom. Further details would be sent at this time.

## Footwear

We ask that children wear black shoes rather than trainers or boots whenever possible. Children are welcome to wear boots during periods of extreme weather; for example, when there is snow on the ground.
