Allocation Statement for Enmore C of E Primary School

Enmore Church of England Primary School received 58 preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd choices). **This school has a published Admission Number of 21.** 26 children were allocated higher preference schools by the Local Authority, reducing the number of preferences to 32. **23 places have been offered in the first round.**

When the Admissions Committee of the Governing Body considered the equally ranked list of the 58 preferences, it was agreed that it could offer 23 places in total for September 2025 because based on numbers at that time the total sum of three consecutive year groups i.e. Reception 2025, Current Reception and Current Year 1 would create a sum of 64 – Reference Admissions Policy.

How the Allocation of Places was made:

The 23 places have been offered to pupils under the following criteria.

	Criterion	Number of places offered
1.	Looked After Children and previously Looked After Children. (Previously looked after children are children who were looked after, but ceased to be so because they were adopted, or became subject to a residence order or special guardianship order)	0
2.	Children who at the time of application reside in the ecclesiastical parishes of Enmore or Goathurst;	4
3.	Children with a sibling (living at the same address) attending the school at the time the child will start school;	9
4.	Children of school staff	0
5	Any further places will be decided by proximity of the child's home to the school, as measured by the shortest distance, using a GIS system if necessary. (The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 4.162 miles).	10
